


*"If you had responded to my rebuke, I would have poured out


May my descendants live in a constant awareness of Your



Psalm 43:3-4


Let my descendants be guided by Your Light and Your Truth.

Psalm 86:11-12



Philippians 1:9-11



Romans 5:3-5


